The E.W. Marland Mansion is a 43,561 square foot Mediterranean Revival-style mansion. Built by oil baron and philanthropist E.W. Marland, as a display of wealth in the peak of the 1920s oil boom, the house is one of the largest residences in the southwestern U.S. , and is known as the "Palace on the Prairie." The mansion was constructed between 1925 and 1928, and influenced by the Palazzo Davanzati in Florence, Italy. Breathtakingly beautiful, this "American Castle" denotes incredible attention to detail with carved wood, sculptured stone, wrought iron arched doorways, Waterford crystal chandeliers and hand-painted and gold-leaf ceilings.

It was E.W.'s dream that his showplace would host the grandest affairs. On Friday night, this dream will be realized as Carl and Brenda Renfro host an epic Cherokee Strip bash at the Mansion with a spirit and grandeur that would make E.W. Marland proud! In addition to dinner, drinks, and the ENDLESS SUMMER experience, you can expect a few surprises like dancing, hidden gambling dens, secret passageways, and speakeasies. It will be TOTALLY TUBULAR!

The **PONCA CITY** COUNTRY CLUB

("PCCC") has roots that go back to E.W. Marland and the oil boom era. The original name of the land and facilities was the Marland Institute, which was built in the 1920's. Continental Oil Company generously transferred the property to start the Ponca City Country Club in 1945. The current clubhouse at PCCC was opened in 1947. The Clubhouse sits high on a bluff overlooking the Arkansas river valley and the oak covered Osage hills in the distance.

The PCCC Golf Course was originally designed by legendary architect Perry Maxwell in the 1920s. Improvements have been made throughout the years by other notable designers such as A.W. Tillinghast and Don Sechrest, as well as local professional Bill Oliver. Simply stated, if you enjoy rolling terrain with tree-lined doglegs, you will love this course.



MEMORIAL GOLF COURSE was opened in 1953 and designed by Floyd Farley. The course is nestled on the east side of Lake Ponca in Ponca City and features 125 acres of trees and rolling terrain. Dubbed by the people of Ponca City as "the great meeting of lake and trees", the course connects rolling, tree-lined doglegs with beautiful, sweeping views of Lake Ponca. The course bounds through a daring lakescape before giving way to the understated natural beauty and brawn of the famous Osage Hills.



Friday night at the Marland Mansion, we'll hang loose with ENDLESS SUMMER - a Beach Boys tribute with some Frankie Valli and Yacht Rock tunes thrown in. You can relive the classic surf and hot rod sounds as this six-piece show takes you on a musical journey to the fabulous 60s.
